

Biographical Information for Joseph R. Egan

Mr. Egan, the Chairman of Egan & Associates, has managed several of the highest profile nuclear matters in the world in recent years on behalf of clients from as many as eighteen countries, including government, utilities, individuals, and commercial entities.

He is a former station-certified nuclear reactor engineer with degrees in Physics, Nuclear Engineering (M.S.), and Technology & Policy (M.S.) from MIT, and a law degree from Columbia University, when he was Stone Scholar and winner of the Wertheimer Prize.

Prior to founding Egan & Associates, Mr. Egan was partner at Shaw Pittman Potts & Trowbridge in Washington, D.C., and a senior associate at LeBoeuf Lamb Greene & McRae in New York City, specializing in nuclear regulatory, environment, and public utilities law and litigation.

Mr. Egan has worked on-site as a reactor engineer for Commonwealth Edison Company, as an Energy Analyst for Argonne National Laboratory's International Energy Program, and was a Nuclear Licensing Engineer for the New York Power Authority. He has also independently consulted on energy matters for such organizations as the United Nations, Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory, the South Pacific Commission, and the Midwest Research Institute.

He has authored feature articles and editorials or been featured in the *New York Times*, *The Boston Globe* (front-page series), *The Wall Street Journal*, *The London Times*, *CNN Worldwide*, *National Public Radio*, *Monitor Radio*, *the International and Herald Tribune*, *Technology Review*, *the Nation*, *Energy*, *Nuclear News*, *Environmental Law Reporter*, *Hazardous Materials Intelligence Report*, and *Nuclear Industry*. Mr. Egan is a co-author of the book, Nuclear Energy Law After Chernobyl (Graham & Trotman: London 1988), and authored the "Chemistry & Physics" and "Energy chapters of Knopfs Science Almanac 1984/85. He was nominated for the AAAS Science Writing Award, and has presented numerous papers and spoken on nuclear, energy and environmental matters worldwide. Mr. Egan has also appeared on ABC News "Good Morning America."

Mr. Egan is a member of the Federal Energy Bar Association, International Nuclear Law Association, the American Nuclear Society, the New York State Bar Association, and the Nuclear Energy Institute's Lawyers Committee. He is admitted in New York, the District of Columbia, the D.C. Circuit, the Fourth Circuit, the Fifth Circuit, and the U.S. Supreme Court.
