Mr. Kitano received his B.A. in Sociology from the University of Tokyo (Faculty of Letters), 1980. He received his Masters in International Relations from the University of Geneva (Graduate Institute of International Studies of Geneva), 1996.

Mr. Kitano joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) of Japan in 1980. He worked in the Asian Bureau, North American Bureau, and the Economic Cooperation Bureau of MOFA from 1984 to 1991. He was the first secretary, Embassy of Japan in China, from 1991 to 1993, first secretary, Permanent Mission to the International Organizations in Geneva from 1993 to 1995, Legal Counselor, Cabinet Legislation Bureau of Government of Japan from 1995 to 1998, and was the Director, Science and Nuclear Affairs Division, MOFA, from 1998.
