

Biographical Information for Vladislav Aleksandrovich Petrov

Dr. Petrov was born on 26 January 1958 and is a citizen of Russia. He received his Diploma as Mining Engineer-Geologist, in August 1984 from the Moscow Geology Prospecting Institute. In 1994, he received his Ph.D. from the Russian Academy of Sciences.

Dr. Petrov has been a member of the International Association of Structural/Tectonic Geologists (IASTG), since 1995. In addition, since 1988, he has been a member of the Geological Society of America, Structural Geology and Tectonics Division.

Dr. Petrov has served as the Scientific Council Secretary, Senior Scientific Researcher and Head of Division of Structural Petrophysics, at the Institute of Geology of Ore Deposits, Petrography, Mineralogy and Geochemistry (IGEM), Russian Academy of Sciences. He has been with this institute for 16 years.

Dr. Petrov's expertise includes the Geology of Uranium Deposits, Radioactive Waste Management and Environmental Remediation. His experience includes research and fieldwork on Uranium deposits in the Krasnokamensk District, SE Siberia, Russia (1984 to present); Uranium, Gold, Lead-Zinc and Fluorite deposits in NE Mongolia (1985 to 1991); and Radioactive Waste Management and Environmental Remediation in the Chelyabinsk Region, Russia (1991-present).

Dr Petrov is the author and co-author of more than 80 articles and reports for the Government and various publications.
